So, what does that mean and what is the difference between the two terms? The simplest answer is compound interest! The most important distinction between the two is compound interest. The interest rate is the rate that is earned on the original amount of money. The APY is interest that is earned on the original amount and the amount of compound interest earned in one year. While this can be a complex question, the thing to remember is compound interest allows your money to grow quicker over time.
